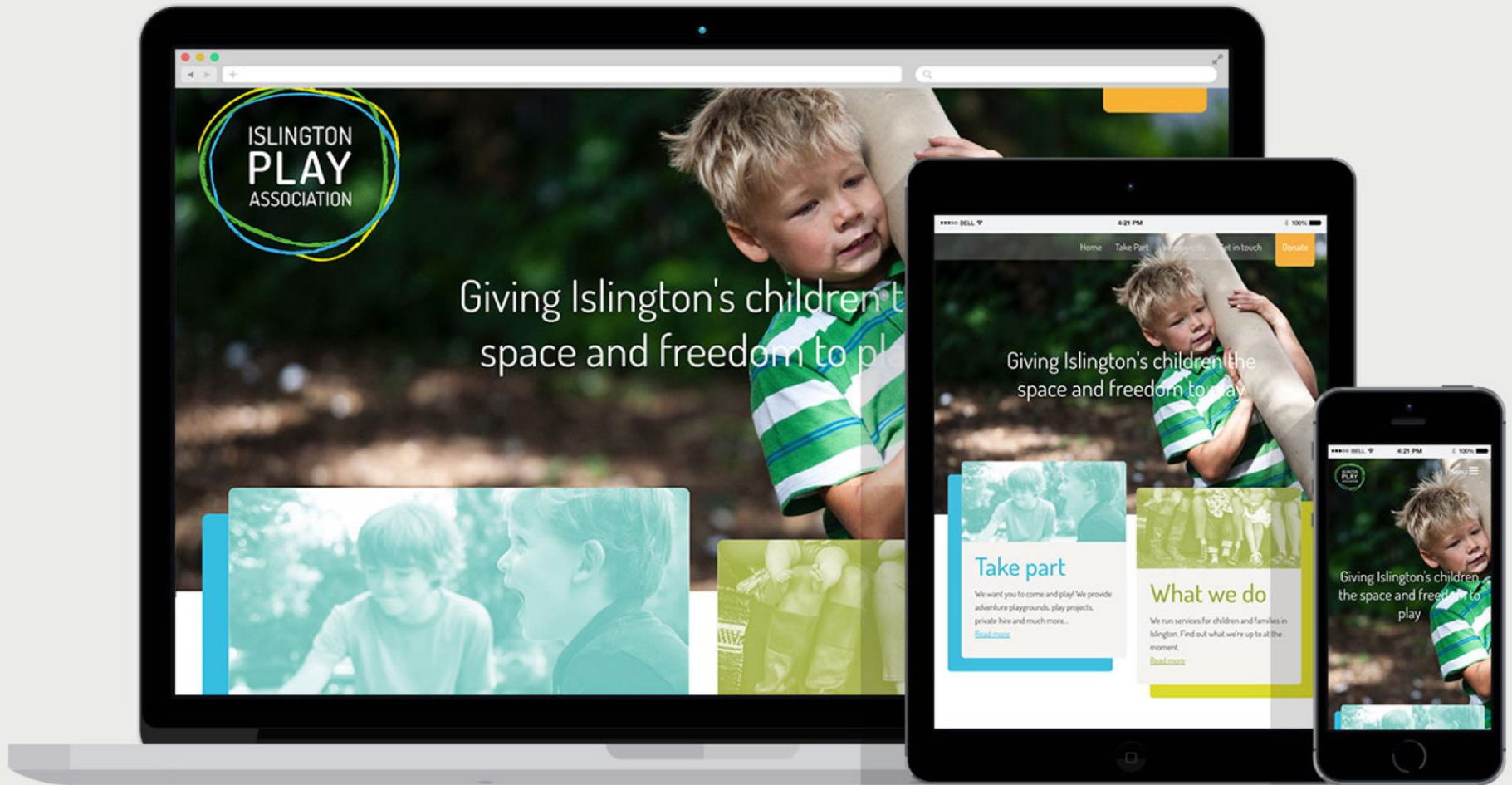


COLOUR PALETTE

Paradise Park Children's Centre

Paradise Park Children's Centre is a haven for families with children under five. We aim to be a welcoming and warm space so that local families can find a place to spend time with their children, get information about services and play.

Our community cafe offers healthy food and snacks throughout the week and we often run workshops, activities and sessions on food, play and children's issues.

Our nursery provides great early education and operates an open door policy from the building to the garden, ensuring that children can play outside whenever they want whether it rains or shines, allowing them to feel freedom and make choices from the earliest opportunity. We offer forest school sessions and free play, we have fires, a massive sandpit and loads of water play. All the food is cooked from scratch on site thereby ensuring that children get access to all the elements they need to build healthy bodies and minds.

History

Paradise Park Children's Centre was built by Islington Play Association and Islington Council in 2005. The money was partly raised through IPA's neighbourhood nursery in Arundel Square, which then transferred into the current Paradise Park site in December 2005. Some of our staff have been there from the very beginning and have been part of developing the amazing free play nursery with us.

Originally the building housed IPA's nursery and the Hillmorton Sure Start offices and then the two were amalgamated under IPA as one children's centre in 2006/7. Since then we have built the centre into a one stop shop for local families, encompassing health services like midwives and health visitors, family support, ESOL classes, healthy eating sessions and much more.

Paradise Park was the first ever under-fives setting to be awarded Quality in Play.



Opening Hours

Paradise Park Nursery: Our nursery is open 9am - 6pm everyday for 48 weeks of the year. Reception is open 9am - 5pm for you to get information about local services.

Community Cafe: Our community cafe is open for tea, coffee and healthy snacks from 10.00am - 4.00pm. You can enjoy a free, healthy lunch and enjoy free activities with your little ones on Tuesdays and Wednesdays in the school holidays.

Holiday Playscheme

Do you need childcare for a 3-5 year old over the school holidays? Paradise Park Children's Centre provides safe and secure childcare in the heart of Islington.
