What materials are you going to use to construct your building?

Once you've selected your materials, carefully cut them out and stick them down over the building outline below. If you can't see a material you would like to use then create your own using pens, pencils or crayons!

1 ROOF

The roof can be a space for play too, what could it look like? A green roof can even attract bees, bugs and birds!



2 EXTERNAL WALLS

We need a strong durable material to make sure the building lasts a long time. It needs to be waterproof as well so we don't get any leaks. Can we use colour, texture and pattern to make the building look fun and exciting?



3 GREEN TECHNOLOGY

If you want to power the building with green energy, then add solar panels and wind turbines to the roof!



4 INSULATION

We want to wrap our building in lots of insulation so it uses less energy to keep it warm inside and has a small carbon footprint which is good for the environment. Think about using natural or recycled insulation to make the building even more sustainable.






5 INTERNAL WALLS
